The Luzerner Pensionskasse (Lucerne Pension Fund) has completed two sixand seven-storey buildings to be used as student accommodation. The development will also include small commercial spaces to bring the residential area to life.

Project description

The HWW residential property comprises one six-storey and one seven-storey residence with 404 student rooms and 23 ateliers intended for commercial use. The student rooms include studios and shared accommodation; each room has a private bathroom. There is plenty of space for students to meet in the common areas. The building has been certified to MINERGIE-P-Eco standards. Heating is generated by the ETH Zurich energy grid and electricity by a photovoltaic system installed on the roof.
